Give Me the Bible

A popular gospel song, and one that we sing frequently at the Pippin Church of Christ, is entitled Give Me The Bible. There are times when perhaps it is easy to sing the words of a song without thinking as deeply and meaningfully as to the meaning and the significance of those words. The words of this powerful hymn are compelling and challenging; they are listed below for reflection.

Verse 1: Give me the Bible, star of gladness gleaming, to cheer the wand'rer lone and tempest tossed;
No storm can hide that radiance peaceful beaming, since Jesus came to seek and save the lost.

Verse 2: Give me the Bible, when my heart is broken, when sin and grief have filled my soul with fear;
Give me the precious words by Jesus spoken, hold up faith's lamp to show my Savior near.

Verse 3: Give me the Bible, all my steps enlighten, teach me the danger of these realms below;
That lamp of safety o'er the gloom shall brighten, that light alone the path of peace can show.

Verse 4: Give me the Bible, lamp of life immortal, hold up that splendor by the open grave;
Show me the light from Heaven's shining portal, show me the glory gilding Jordan's wave.

Refrain: Give me the Bible, holy message shining, thy light shall guide me in the narrow way,

Precept and promise, law and love combining, till night shall vanish in eternal day.

Verse 1 states that the Bible is the ultimate source of cheerfulness for the lonely and downtrodden. Furthermore, this verse proclaims that the Bible provides strength to weather the storms of life and produce peace in the midst of those storms. No wonder Jesus issued the remarkable invitation. (Mt. 11:28-30) Do you reach for and trust the Bible in times of loneliness and trouble? Do you rely on it and the message of Jesus, knowing that all other messages are sure to fail eventually?

Verse 2 highlights the Bible as the source of comfort and guidance in times of hardship, mistakes, sin, and fear. In this way, the Bible is an unfailing book to edify in the way of goodness. Though the things of this world fade and disappoint, the Bible is always true and grand. Do you turn to the Scriptures when hard times arrive and fear grips your spirit?

Verse 3 declares the Bible as the source of enlightenment, towering above all of the weak, misguided, and fragile speculations of mankind. The Bible reveals the real nature of takes place here on earth; it shows the danger as well as the safety of every action, thought, and word. Only the Bible can bring the peace that God wishes mankind to know. (Phil. 4:7) Do you use the Bible for instruction and enlightenment?

Verse 4 affirms the Bible as the masterpiece for information about life and about death. Only the Bible can prepare a person for death and what is beyond it. Only the Bible can make a life that is godly and ready for the Day of Judgment. Only by the Bible can one die in the Lord and thus be ready to by privileged to enter Heaven. (Rev. 14:13) Death is the curtain beyond which no man due to flesh alone can look. Do you turn time and again to the Bible to learn how to live here so that you can live hereafter.

The refrain speaks of the light of the Bible (Ps. 119:105), the precepts of the Bible (Ps. 119:15f), the promises of the Bible (2 Tim. 4:8; Jam. 1:12), the laws of the Bible (Ps. 119:142), and the love expressed in the Bible (Jn. 3:16). The Bible is an incredible blessing from God. When we sing about it, let us sing with enthusiasm because we are excited as never before about the meaning and words of the song.
