The apostle Paul tells us that "All the promises of God in him are yes, and in him amen, to the glory of God through us." (2 Cor. 1:20). God's promises are sure and faithful. We can rely on Him to keep His word.

When Jesus said, "He that believes and is baptized shall be saved" (Mark 16:16). He meant it. You can count on it. No matter what man says concerning salvation, that is what Jesus said.

God promises eternal life to the obedient. Peter tells us that God has given us "exceedingly great and precious promises" (2 Pet. 1:4). In the book of Hebrews, we read about those. The writer tells of some who "died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth" (Heb. 11:13).
