If You Know These Things, Blessed Are You If You Do Them

The statement Jesus made in John 13:17 is an interesting one. In this context He is talking about the lesson in humility that He had just taught the apostles by washing their feet. The principle is applicable in many other areas as well. Look at the statement in detail.
