The Second Time

In my opinion, there are but a few words recorded in the Bible that are as encouraging than the words recorded in Jonah 3:1. The text says, "Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the second time."

As you surely know, Jonah, the prophet, attempted to run from God and his responsibility as one of God's spokesmen. His desertion was not a matter of fear for his own safety but was a matter of his corrupt heart. He knew that if he obeyed God, Ninevah would repent, God would forgive them, the people would not be destroyed, and that was not the outcome Jonah desired (Jonah 4:2).
