Do We Really Believe?

Many people in the world profess a belief in the God of the bible, but do they really believe that He can and will do what He says He will do? It's easy enough to say that we believe, but our actions will really "tell the tale". Take, for example, the Isrealites of Moses' day. You would be hard pressed to find any group of people who had more reason to believe in God and His power than they. They personally witnessed the plagues that God brought upon Egypt, they saw the Red Sea parted and walked across on dry land, they were fed with manna from heaven (Exodus 7-16), yet we are told in Hebrews 3:19 that they could not enter the promised land "because of unbelief". They didn't believe that God could do, or would do what He had said that He would do.

We have sufficient evidence today to believe in the God of the bible and His power. In John 20:31 John said that the things he had written were so that we "might believe and believing have life in His name." In Romans 1:20 the apostle Paul writes that, "His eternal power and Godhead" are clearly seen from a study of the creation around us so that we are, "without excuse". In spite of all the available evidence and in spite of their words, the actions of many people proclaim their unbelief. The author of Hebrews warns us that what happened to the Isrealites might also happen to us. We might not be able to enter God's promised rest, "because of unbelief" (Hebrews 3:12-19), if we don't believe that God can and will do what He says He will do and act on that belief.

"Beware brethren, lest there be in any of you a heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; but exhort one another daily, while it is called 'Today', lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, while it is said: 'Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.'" Hebrews 3:12-15 NKJV

Building for Eternity

Automobile executive Lee Iacocca died recently (July 2, 2019). He oversaw the development of the popular Ford Mustang (1965) which remains a very successful line. As the 1960's gave way to the 1970's Iacocca saw the trends developing for a new kind of car: smaller, economical, affordable. And so, with the 1971 model, the Pinto was born.

Ford was not able to successfully repeat their success they experienced with the Mustang. Once of the Pinto's major problem arose with the car's basic design to have a small car with adequate truck space. To achieve that goal the choice was made to place the car's gas tank between the rear axle and the rear bumper. Accidents were followed by lawsuits which initiated a considerable amount of bad publicity and the resulting decline in sales led to the Pinto's quiet death in 1980 (autoweek.com).

Some product design plans in the manufacturing world enjoy great success while others do not. The same is true in the realm of spiritual growth except in that area the plans can be clearly identified as of either divine or human origin. If it is made by man, beware. It will prove defective. If it is from God, it will lead you to heaven (Galatians 1:6-12).
